Advocate for White Lake designation as a Critical Environmental Area (CEA) -- the first in Sullivan County!

Participate in year two of the NY State water sampling program (CSLAP) to monitor algae blooms, and to assess phosphorus, nitrogen and other water quality levels in the lake.

Attend and provide input to the Town of Bethel's Comprehensive Plan Open House on June 2.

Participate in the USDA in NY State program to manage the goose population to healthy and sustainable levels.

Initiate the process to establish the White Lake watershed and this designated inland waterway as part of the New York State Local Waterfront Revitaliztion Program (LWRP).
